GLEN RIDGE SCHEDULES REGISTRATION FOR PRE-KINDERGARTEN & KINDERGARTEN FOR SEPTEMBER 2024

Registration for Glen Ridge children who will enter the four-year-old Pre-kindergarten (Pre-K) and five-year-old Kindergarten program in September 2024 will occur online at: (www/glenridge.org) from January 12th - January 22nd, 2024.

Students will be registered in the Glen Ridge Public Schools and notified of their child's school placement at a later date.

At the time of registration, the following documentation must be uploaded by the parent/guardian and approved by the District in order to enroll:

- 1) Original birth certificate
- 2) Student health records (it is essential that all immunization and health records be complete at the time of registration; the health form is on the registration webpage)
- 3) Proof of residency
 - Supporting documentation of proof of residency is <u>one</u> of the following:
 - 1) Property tax bill
 - 2) Deed
 - 3) Settlement statement or lease;
 - Plus one of the following
 - 1) Current utility bill
 - 2) Credit card receipt
 - 3) Itemized bill
 - 4) Bank statement
 - 5) Voter registration card
 - 6) Court orders or agreements with state agencies.

The online registration process and the primary school zones can be accessed by going to the Glen Ridge Public Schools website – www.glenridge.org. Online registration forms will be accepted starting January 12th. Students currently in Pre-K need not re-register for Kindergarten.

According to the Board of Education policy, Glen Ridge children must be four years old by October 1, 2024, to be eligible for the four-year-old Pre-K program in September 2024. To be eligible to enter the five-year-old Kindergarten program in September 2024, Glen Ridge children must be five years old by October 1, 2024.

Also, according to Board of Education policy, the Superintendent may review existing boundary lines and recommend to the Board such changes as may be justified by an educationally sound balance of student populations. A student's school placement for the Glen Ridge Pre-K program does not dictate the student's future school placement for Kindergarten. It is possible that a child will attend one school for Pre-K and then attend another for Kindergarten through Grade 2.
