- Ms. Ginsburg reported on written communications since the last board meeting, including communications from the GRBDIA on district diversity plans, from Karima Ravenell with regard to job postings on the Columbia Teachers College job portal, and from Erin Garcia with regard to virtual education students and school celebrations.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- Ms. Ginsburg announced Governor Murphy's nomination for the Department of Education Commissioner, Dr. Angelica Allen-McMillan. Dr. Allen-McMillan will be Acting Commissioner pending approval of her appointment by the New Jersey Senate.
- Ms. Ginsburg recognized the retirements of Duke Mendez and Kay Scheren, congratulating them both.
- Ms. Ginsburg reviewed the district and board goals with the board. There was an opportunity to discuss and ask questions.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Mr. Phillips recognized the retirements of Duke Mendez (GRHS PE/Health/Drivers' Ed) and Kay Scheren (GRHS Admin. Asst.).
- Mr. Phillips provided an update on the district, which included the reopening of the high school, recent COVID-19 cases in the district, and the 2019-2020 SAT results.
- The superintendent recognized the Glen Ridge Educational Foundation's generous gift to fund nine teachers' training and certification in Orton-Gillingham, at a cost of \$94,500. Mr. Phillips thanked the foundation for their continued dedication to the students and the school district.

- Michele Militello, resident, asked if auditing of class meets has been considered and if there has been consideration for lengthening the school day. Mr. Phillips responded that he will follow up with the principals for feedback on auditing class meets. Mr. Phillips noted that as we consider Phase II, we are concerned with the numbers increasing in the county and the state. We are hesitant to create more opportunities for exposure.
