

Senior Privileges

The privilege to leave school grounds is granted to seniors for their study halls during Periods 1, 5-8 and their lunch period only. A senior can only leave Period 5 & 7 during their study halls if it backs up against their lunch period. **There will be no triple lunch periods.** A senior who has study hall Period 1 may report to school at 8:45 a.m., and a student with a Period 8 study hall may leave school at 2:01. When a student leaves school grounds, many formal school mechanisms no longer apply and the student must be able to exhibit individual responsibility for their actions.

All seniors who use these privileges must adhere to the following rules (and the provisions of the Parent/Student Handbook) or face forfeiture of these privileges.

1. Seniors will leave school grounds at the beginning of the period in a quick and orderly manner as well as return to school without disruptions to those students still in class.
2. Students will return to school and report to their assigned classes on time. Mechanical problems with cars or extra time needed to do errands, etc. is not an excuse to be late.
3. Seniors who fail (or are in danger of failing) a course will be placed in a regular study hall and attendance will be mandatory.
4. Seniors will not leave school grounds with under classmen.
5. Any violation of school rules or the criminal code will result in the immediate revocation of these privileges.
6. Students will not be allowed to leave school and then call in sick.
7. Students will not be allowed to loiter on school grounds. This includes the wall in front of the school, the sidewalks, the main entrance to the school, and all parking areas both in the school lot and on the street.

All parties understand that the Glen Ridge Board of Education or its employees are not liable for any injury, property damage, or personal liability that a student may incur or cause while off school grounds for lunch.

All seniors leaving the building must provide an emergency cell phone number and email address in the event of a lockdown or other emergency situation.
