<u>Ridgewood Avenue Discovery Series – Rules and Procedures</u>

Registration – The registration period begins on November 22nd, 2022 and closes on December 24th, 2022. Follow these two easy steps to register:

- Register ONLINE at https://glenridge.wufoo.com/forms/discovery-registration-winter-2023/
- Pay via PayPal (**All payments must be made online**)
- 1. Payment Pay Pal ONLY. NO CASH. NO CHECKS. Your child's spot in his/her desired class will only be held once payment has been received online. Payments must be received by the close of registration, otherwise your child's spot will not be held. Early registration fees must be paid by midnight on Dec. 9 or the course fee will revert to regular registration fees. All payment must be in by Dec. 27 or it is subject to the late fee.
- 2. Fees- Transaction fees have been included in the price of each class. Any registrations after 12/24 will be accepted on a case to case basis and subject to a non-refundable \$25 late fee + class fee.
- **3. Full Classes** Classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Once a class has reached its maximum, we will open a Wait List. Email rasdiscovery@glenridge.org to be added to the Wait List once a class is full. If spots in the class become available or a second section is added, we will offer those spots starting at the top of the Wait List.
- **4. Refunds and Reimbursements** Absolutely no refunds will be issued after the close of registration. If an issue

arises with a class, please either speak to the onsite coordinator or email RASDiscovery@glenridge.org and the issue will be addressed with the instructor. **No refunds can be given once registration closes.**

- **5.** Change Requests Absolutely no class change requests will be honored after the close of registration.
- **6. School closings -** Discovery is in session **when school is in session.** If school is cancelled or closed, Discovery is not in session. If school closes early for emergency reasons, class will be held on the designated make up day and there will be no refund.
- **7. Classes cancelled by teacher -** If a teacher must cancel class, you will be notified via e-mail ASAP so it is important that you provide an active e-mail address.
- **8. Make-up classes** Regardless of teacher illness or emergency closings, there is only ONE make-up class per session. Additional make up classes, if needed, will be added on to the end of the session.
- 9. Class Start and End Times Promptness at the start of class and prompt pick-up at the end of class is expected. Late class/second session: Children cannot stay in the school until the second class. Parents are responsible for the supervision and safety of their child prior to the start of class and at the end of class.
- **10.Disruptive Behavior** Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. All students are expected to be respectful and courteous to each other, to the teachers, and to the building before, during, and after class time. If a student does not follow the teacher's rules, s/he will be asked to leave and may be asked not to attend the remaining classes. No refunds will be given for disruptive behavior.
- **11.Aftercare** Please indicate if your child is in aftercare on a day they have Discovery. Aftercare will be provided with a list of participating students. You agree to allow aftercare to release students for class.
- **12.Confirmation** Confirmation emails will be sent as soon as possible after the close of registration. You will be notified of room assignments and reminded of class dates as part of the confirmation process. All classes will be held on site at Ridgewood Avenue School.

Dungeons & Dragons

Grades: 5-6 Day: Mondays Time: 3:15-4:15

Frequency: 4 sessions - 1/23, 1/30, 2/13, 2/27 make-up date: 3/13

Cost: \$145 (early bird reg: \$135)

Description: In Dungeons & Dragons, the players form an adventuring party who explore fantasy worlds together as they embark on epic quests and level up in experience. In this

discovery class students will choose their characters and the basic mechanics of dungeons and dragons. They will use their imaginations to solve puzzles and overcome obstacles that are in their way. It is also an amazing opportunity to make some new friends as we sit around the table in the fantasy world that they are helping to shape. Along with the dice which will determine at every turn whether their actions are successful. Students will have to utilize the strengths of their characters along with their own creativity in order to be successful. Mrs. Tarabocchia will be the dungeon master for up to 10 students in 5th and 6th grade during this 4 hour campaign that will hopefully launch a lifetime of enjoyment in roleplaying games.

Description: Students will learn about piece movements, check, checkmate, stalemate and special moves like castling and en passant. Classes will be a mix of instruction, playing time for games, fun mini-games and fun prize questions designed to make the learning experience as fun

Description: Students in the intermediate level of chess will be introduced to the most important checkmate patterns, practice with tactics like pins, double attacks and skewers.
