RAS Kindle Use and Lending Policy

Many thanks to the RAS Home and School Association for the generous donation of Kindles, Kindle cases, and the books we have on the Kindles!

- Parents, please note that since there are some “young adult” titles on the Kindles, it is suggested that your child make reading choices with your direction. If you are unsure about content, visit the Amazon website for a summary and reviews of the book
- The 2-cycle loan period means that if your child checks out on a Day 3, the Kindle is due back 2 cycles later on Day 3
- The Kindle can be returned earlier, and on a day other than when your students has library class
- Students with overdue books will not be able to borrow a Kindle
- There will be a waiting list when all of the Kindles are checked out
- Kindles will be inspected before and after loan period
