2312 CLASS SIZE

The Board of Education directs that the number of pupils assigned to any one class be governed by considerations of instructional quality and economy of operation.

Class size shall take into account the subject matter, type of instruction, ability of pupils, and use of special facilities and equipment.

As part of the planning process whenever any class size is 25 or more, or 10 or less, the Superintendent shall inform the Board, make a recommendation, and the Board shall have the final determination for the disposition of the class.

Special Education shall be as dictated by N.J.A.C. 6A:14-4.3.
