4240 EMPLOYEE TRAINING

The Board of Education recognizes that the skills required of support staff members change with changing technology. In order to ensure both optimum efficiency in district operations, and the continued growth in expertise of the staff, the Superintendent shall ensure that appropriate programs of in-service training shall be developed for support staff as necessary.

The Superintendent may recommend to the Board the granting of leave for attendance of personnel at state, regional and national job-related meetings without pay deduction and with expenses paid by the school system according to established allowances.

The Superintendent shall arrange development of appropriate in-service presentations, seminars and/or workshops on affirmative action/equity, special education, child abuse, drug/alcohol abuse awareness, handling blood and body fluids, possible hazardous substances in the workplace and other topics specifically required by federal or New Jersey law.
