Spring Fling Update

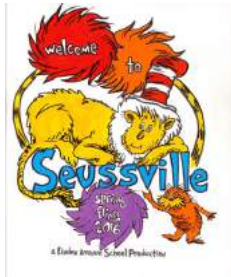
Spring Fling planning kicks into high gear in March.
