Location of the pesticide application: Under Tree Near Walkway from Loading Dock to Gym

Reason for the pesticide application: Hornets

The Date and Time the outdoor application took place: DATE 9/28/21 TIME 12:00Noon

Description of the problem and the factors that qualified the problem as an emergency that threatened the health or safety of a student or staff member: Aggressive stinging insects

If applicable, description of steps to be taken to avoid emergency use of pesticides for this problem in the future: Not applicable

Description of the possible adverse effects of the pesticides as per the Material Safety Data Sheets for the pesticides to be used, if available: (Delta Dust) Caution! May be harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. (PI Contact) Primary routes of exposure: Routes of entry for solids and liquids include eye and skin contact, ingestion and inhalation. Routes of entry for gases include inhalation and eye contact. Skin contact may be a route of entry for liquefied gases. Acute toxicity: Relatively nontoxic after single ingestion. Slightly toxic after short-term skin contact. Relatively nontoxic after short-term inhalation. Irritation / corrosion: May cause slight irritation to the eyes. May cause slight irritation to the skin.

Pesticide product label instructions and precautions related to Public Safety.

(DeltaDust)Caution! May be harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. (PI Contact) EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE.KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.KEEP OUT OF REACH OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS.HARMFUL IF ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN. Avoid contact with the skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Note: as required by law, we are advising you of the following statement:

The Office of Pesticide Programs of the United States Environmental Protection Agency has stated: "Where possible, persons who potentially are sensitive, such as pregnant women, infants, and children, should avoid any unnecessary pesticide exposure."

REMEMBER: Whenever a non-low impact pesticide is used on school property there is also a Restricted Entry Interval (REI) that begins when the pesticide application ends. This Restricted Entry Interval last for seven hours unless the product label uses NUMERIC LANGUAGE, e.g., 4hours or 12 hours; directing a longer or shorter period of time for Restricted Entry. If the product label does not discuss Restricted Entry the period of time defaults to seven (7) hours.
