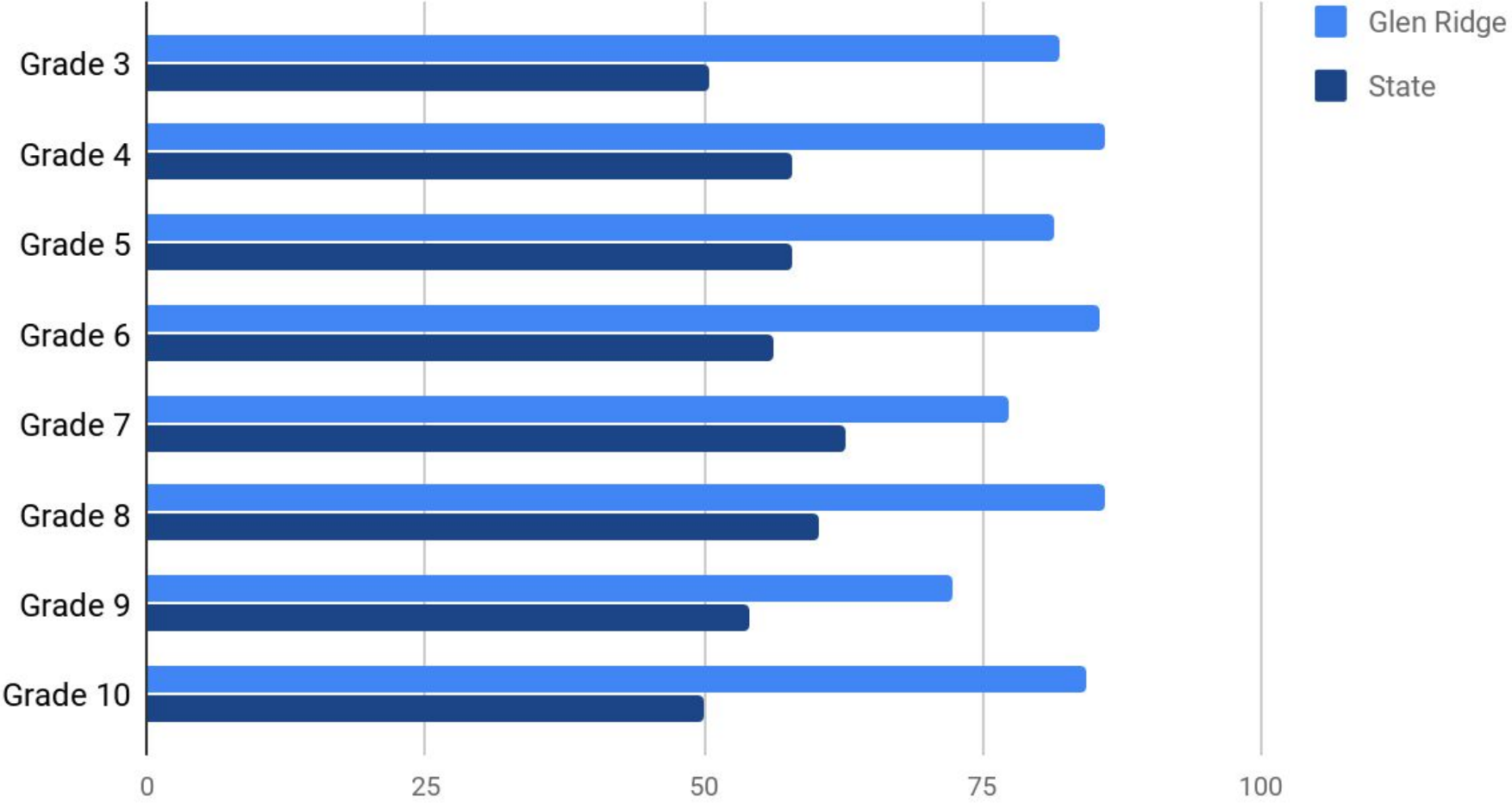

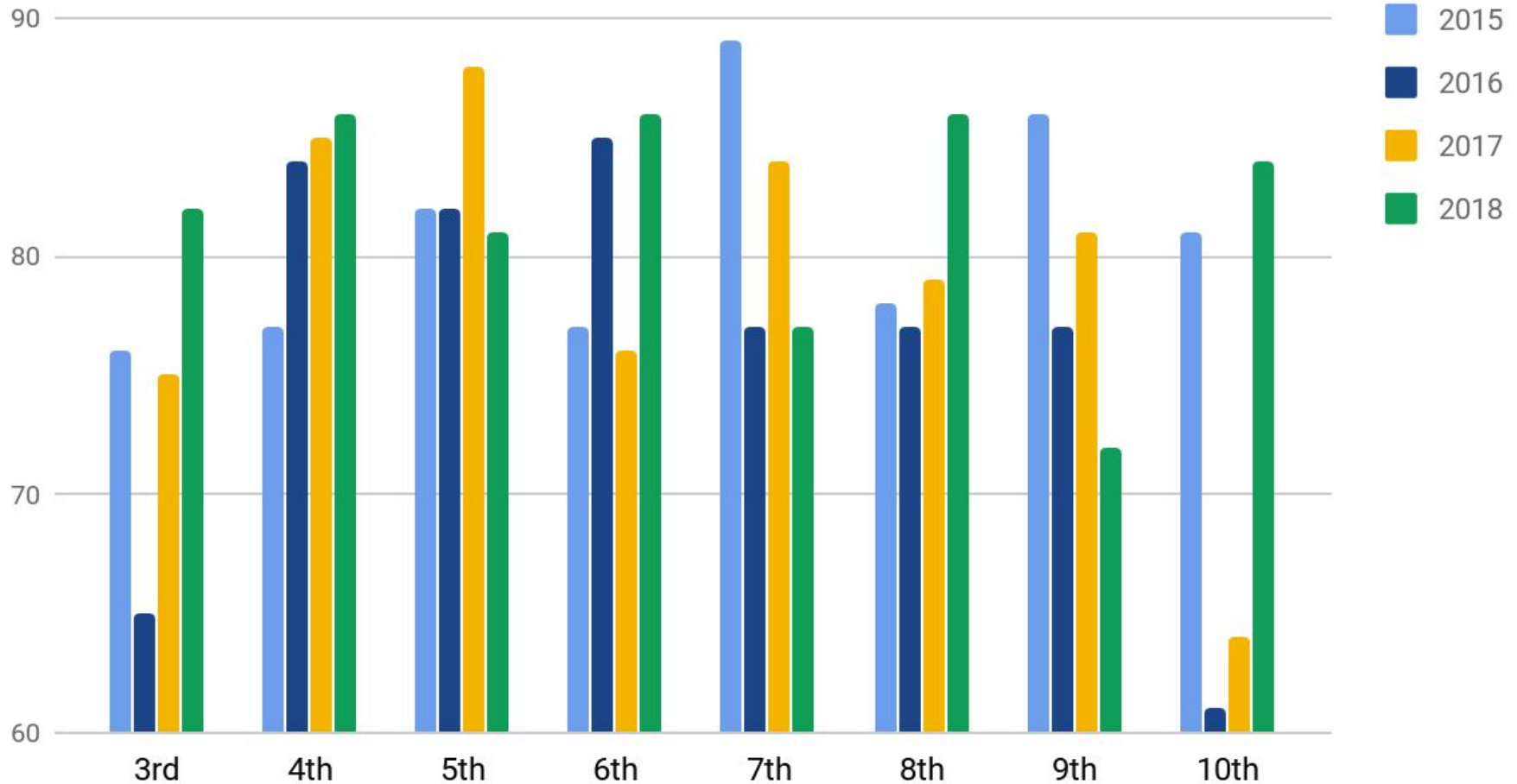

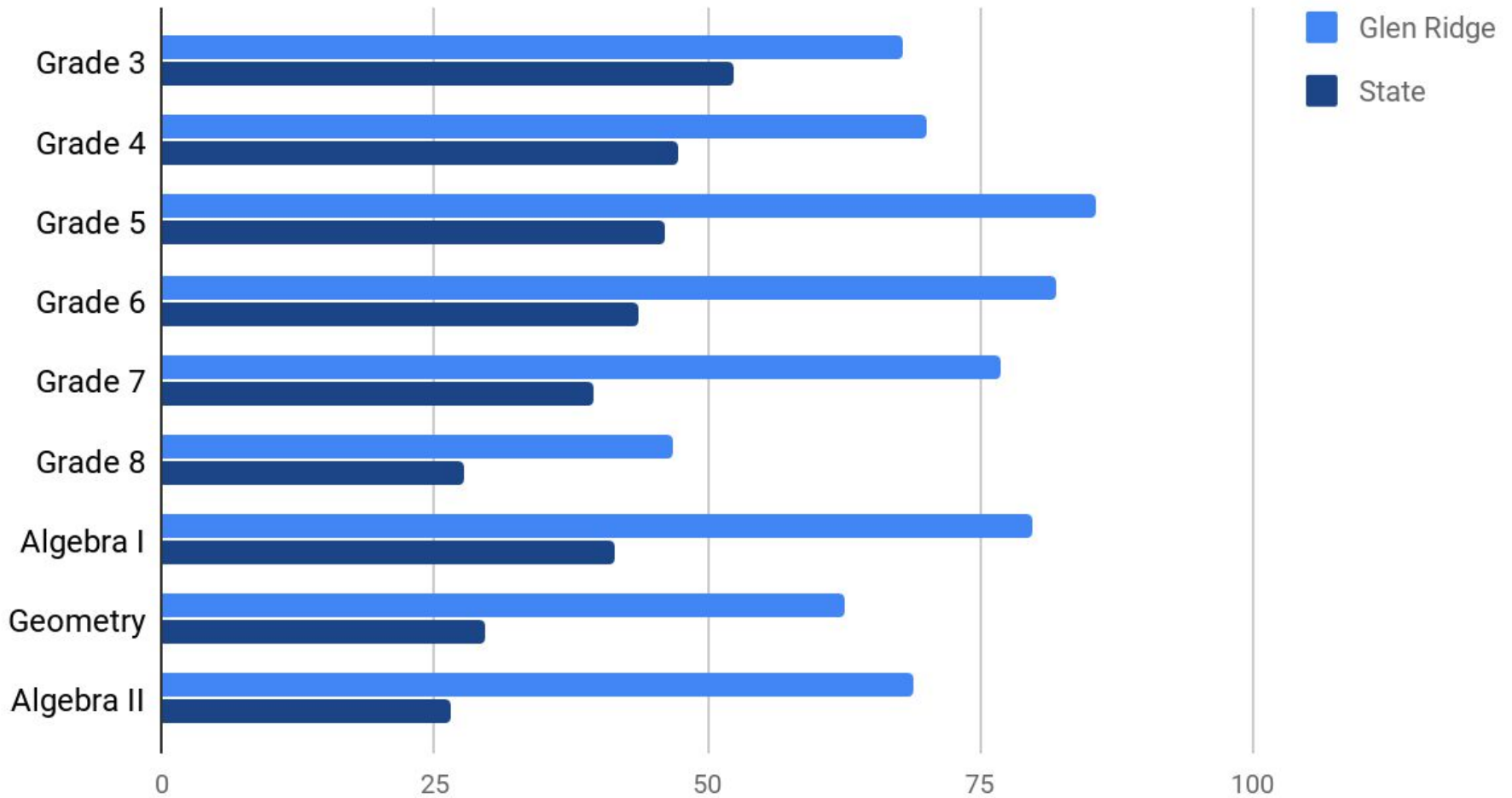
Percent Passing

Math - Percentage Who Scored 4 or 5



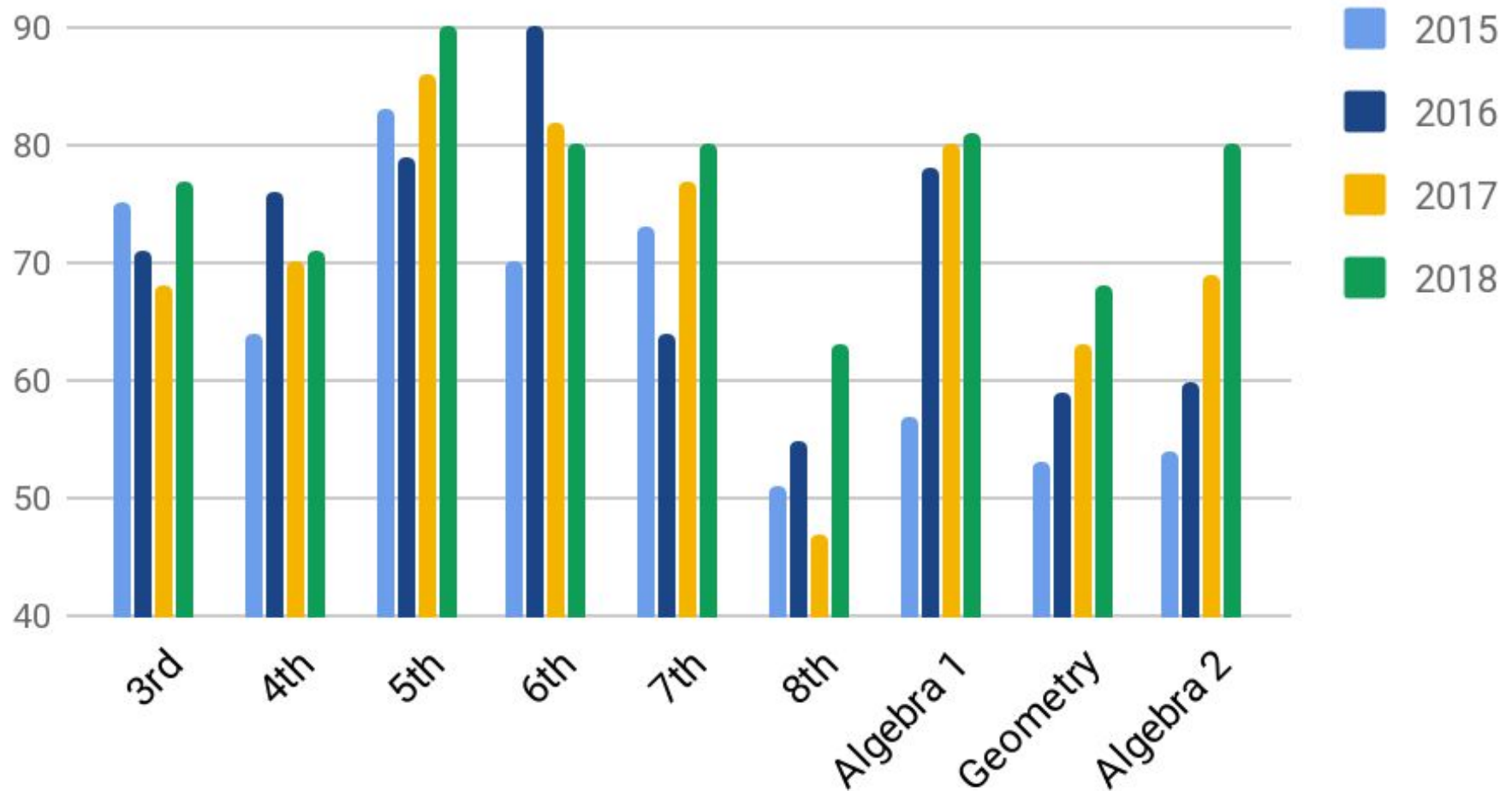

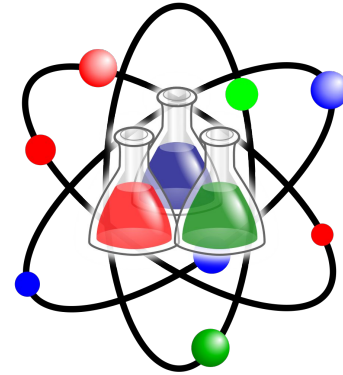
PARCC UPDATES

2018: Field Test - Results not reported to the schools

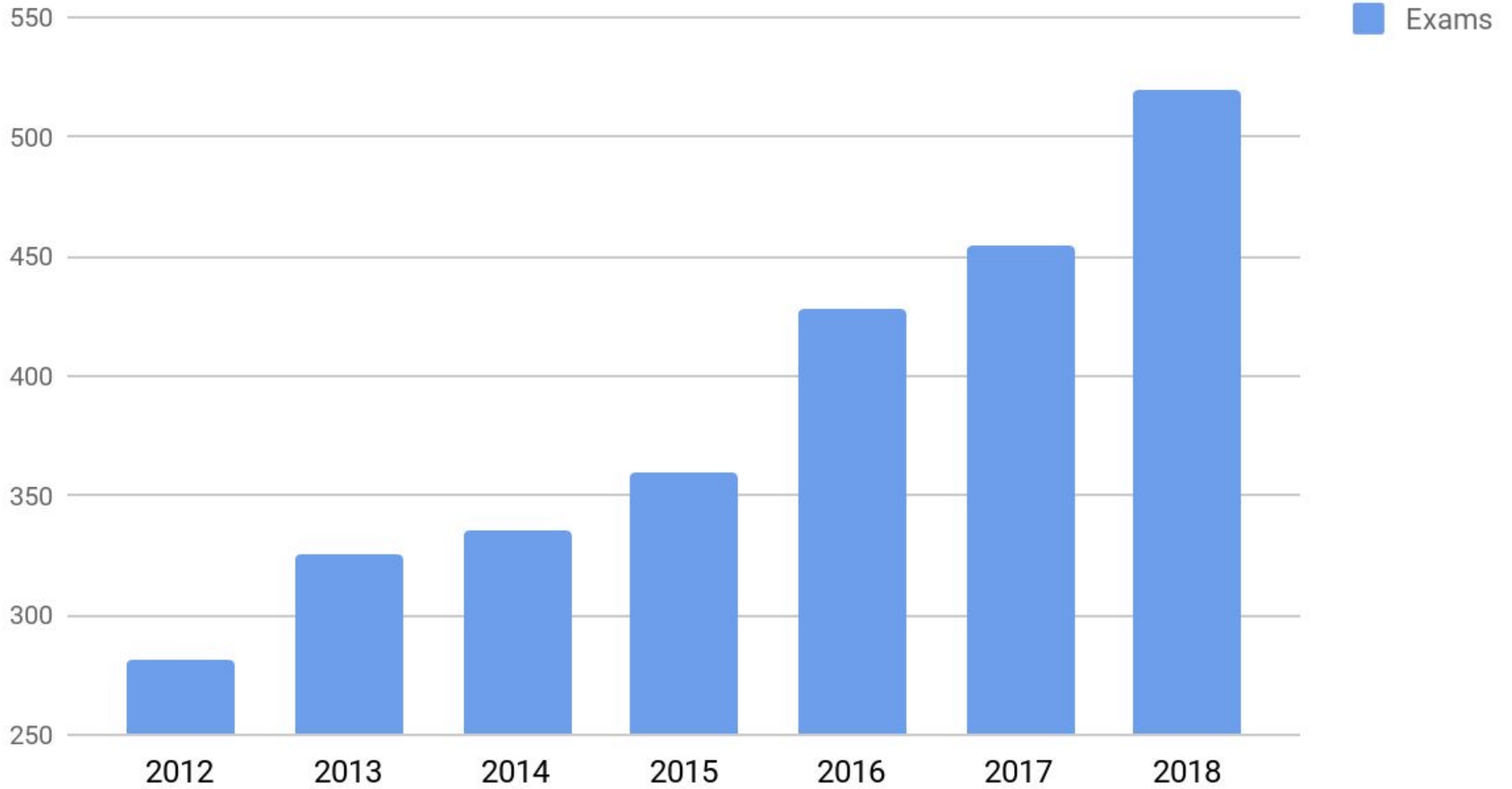
